As one who has recognized Him Who is the object of all knowledge I am submissive to the Will of God, obedient to the teachings of God and stand firm in His Laws and guidance. I have renounced the peoples of the earth, putting my complete reliance upon God as I endeavour to serve the Cause of God and His servants. I actively pursue the teaching work and labor to cause the Word of God to be exalted.

Even though I have abandoned the body and the material focus of life, I have complete health, strength and physical courage. I expend health and well-being of the body in the path of the Kingdom and to the benefit of the human world in general.

I have intellectual perception, discernment, reason and brilliance. I am clean-minded, have elevated thought and complete freedom from prejudice. I continue to develop my knowledge and seek instruction in such arts, sciences

and foreign tongues as are of benefit to humanity. As I search for and serve truth I develop true understanding and universal wisdom.

I have a heartfelt fear of God. I have a pure, kindly and radiant heart filled with ecstasy and love. I am honest, truthful and trustworthy. I have integrity and honour. I am happy, patient and content under all conditions. I have hope, faith, and certitude and place my whole trust and confidence in God. I am loyal and faithful; humble, thankful and modest. I am without malice and tolerant of others. I have true moderation. I use my intuition and sense of shame to guide my actions.

I am generous, kind and benevolent. I am magnanimous and show compassion, goodwill and charity towards my fellow human beings.

I have innate courage and pure intent. I have energy and zeal to pursue my life's goals. I have perseverance, firmness, reliability, resolution, steadfastness and constancy. I fulfill my obligations and keep promises, agreements and covenants. I redeem my pledges and yows and render the Trust of God.

I will maintain chastity outside of marriage. Before I choose a wife I will become thoroughly acquainted with her character. When we marry we will have a mutual attachment and become loving companions and comrades. We will be one with each other for time and eternity. As a father I will instruct my children in reading and writing and all that is in the Holy Tablet. I will consult with my wife about counseling the children over a long period of time.
